Doris says that Ira was forever after “holding the bag”.

Following the war years, Ira and Doris settled in Lewiston, building their own house and home and raising two sons. Doris had always gone to church and sang in a choir. However she had not come to know Christ person-

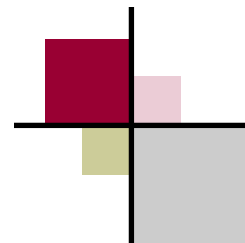

Ira's passion was soul winning and leading new believer bible studies, while Doris' passion would be encouragement through song. forward to meeting her Savior face to face, being free from the sufferings of this life, and to her reunion with that beloved army husband.
