Saturday, April 24th, 176 women from the surrounding areas took part in a nation-wide LIVE Simulcast led by Bible teacher Beth Moore. SLBC was one of 869 sites that collectively hosted approx. 300,000 women. It was clear God had a big work going on that day, and we praise God we were a part of it.

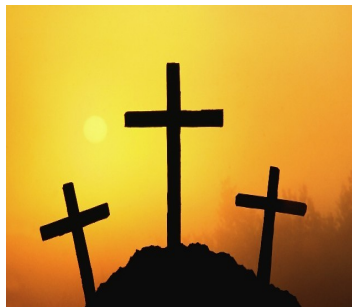
The morning started with a time of worship in song, led by Travis Cottrell, a Dove award-winning worship leader. What a beautiful time of worship to the King.

Beth Moore continued our time of worship as she led us to work out what God's Word has to say about being a secure woman. Our text was Ephesians 4:17-24, where we saw that a secure woman is: 1) **S**aved from herself, 2) **E**ntitled to Truth, 3) **C**lothed in Intention, 4) **U**p-Ended by Grace, 5) **R**ebounded by love, and 6) **E**xceptional in Life. There is not enough space here to give the details but if you think you would like to know please ask someone

who was in attendance that day. It was a great time of study that spoke right to the heart of all who were listening.

To end the sessions, Beth had all 300,000 women across the nation partner up and “speak a word” to each other. Mothers and daughters, grandmothers and granddaughters, neighbors, friends, family, and strangers all joined in commissioning one another to live a life of security.

“Now unto Him Who can keep you from falling, be glory and majesty, power and authority, through Jesus Christ our Lord, now and forever more. Amen.” So long sisters, and So Long Insecurity!
